# Investment Objective and Strategy

The Fund is a bond fund that seeks to achieve stable and long-term growth by investing in government securities and/or high quality corporate debt securities and other liquid fixed income instruments. The Fund's benchmark is the Bloomberg Philippine Sovereign Bond 1-5 Year Index.

#### **Client Suitability**



#### **Outlook and Strategy**

While the BSP continues to warn upside risks on inflation due to the effects of adverse weather conditions on agricultural production, the outlook on local inflation materially improved following President Marcos' approval of the tariff reduction on rice from 35% to 15% until 2028, and on a few other commodities. As we wait for details on its implementation, the market will likely continue to be volatile. Nevertheless, given the better outlook on inflation, it can provide some opportunity to increase exposure on the bond market.

#### **Investment Policy / Prospective Investment**

Pursuant to the fund's objectives, the Trustee, with full discretionary powers, may invest and reinvest the assets of the Fund in: (1) securities issued by the Republic of the Philippines and government-owned or controlled entities including the Bangko Sentral ng Pilipinas (BSP); (2) securities issued by financially sound companies; (3) other liquid fixed income instruments including term deposits; (4) other investment allowed under the regulations issued by the BSP.

# **Related Party Transactions**

The Fund currently has no investment with the Trustee's related parties. Subject to the approval of the Manulife Investment Management and Trust Corporation (Manulife IM (Philippines)) Board of Directors, all related party transactions will be conducted on an arm's length and best execution basis and within the approved limits.
